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| 10 | <b>Lokoya, Mount Veeder, Napa, 2008</b><br>Another blockbuster, the 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon Mt. Veeder which has the largest production, exhibits a deep blue/purple color along with notes of burning embers, charcoal, sweet black currant liqueur, licorice and scorched earth.   | \$ 395.00 |
| 11 | <b>Staglin Estate, Napa, 2009</b><br>Sweet floral notes meld into juicy red berries, spice box and cedar all of which are laced together with remarkable elegance. Silky tannins add to an impression of refinement and total finesse  | \$ 345.00 |
| 12 | <b>Opus One, Napa, 2013</b><br>Velvety textured without a hard edge to be found notes of crème de cassis, blueberry, subtle wood and floral notes gently rise from the wine's dense purple color. Beautifully full-bodied and extraordinarily elegant and pure, this is certainly one of their great achievements over the last 37 years.            | \$ 395.00 |
| 13 | <b>Opus One, Napa, 2011</b><br>This is very aromatic and pretty with plum, cherry and currant aromas, plus hints of chocolate. It is full-bodied with soft, silky tannins and a clean, fresh finish.   | \$ 365.00 |
| 14 | <b>Opus One, Napa, 2009</b><br>Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Malbec, Bordeaux like in its structure and balance showing cedary oak, dusty berry, dried currant and mineral with hints of herb and sage. The flavors firm up on the finish.  | \$ 385.00 |
| 15 | <b>Kathryn Hall Napa 2015</b><br>Unbelievable complexity with a wonderful sucrosity, blue and black fruits in abundance, an opulent, full bodied mouthfeel, but no heaviness or rusticity. This is a seamless, flawless, compelling Cabernet Sauvignon that should drink beautifully upon release and for another 25-30+ years.                      | \$ 275.00 |
| 16 | <b>Robert Mondavi Oakville Reserve, Kalon Vineyard Napa, 2014</b><br>A big wine loaded with black fruit, cedar, licorice, grilled herbs and tar. Layers of flavor build effortlessly to the muscular, virile finish. The wine impresses for its depth, expressive inner perfume and beautifully integrated tannins.                                  | \$ 340.00 |
| 17 | <b>Robert Mondavi Reserve Cabernet 2000</b><br>The wine exhibits a deep purple color as well as an elegant, sweet perfume of black currants intertwined with licorice, loamy soil, and hints of mints as well as new oak. It is ripe, long, and structured, with medium to full body, outstanding purity and concentration, and a persistent finish. | \$360.00  |

- 18 **Joseph Phelps Insignia, 2015** \$ 395.00  
Exhibits a deep garnet-purple color and nose of crushed blackberries and fresh blackcurrants with touches of cigar box, sandalwood, dried lavender, beef drippings and mocha. Medium to full-bodied and incredibly elegant and fine in the mouth, the lively fruit is well structured by grainy tannins and seamless acid, finishing long and earthy.
- 19 **Shafer Hillside Select Cabernet Stags Leap District 2014** \$ 410.00  
Opens with an aromatic wave of deep, intense fruit and spices such as black plum, blackberry pie filling, cassis, and anise, along with nutmeg, dark toast, and dried rose pedals. Open, beautiful ripeness, mocha, briar fruit, pomegranate, baking spice, and ripe tannins promise of sensational things to come in the cellar.
- 20 **Ehlers 1886 2006 Cabernet 2006** \$ 260.00  
Aromas of light cherries, a touch of vanilla wood, and light cigar box. A very easy subtle nose. Flavors of dark cherries, black currant, blueberries, syrup, cocoa and some coffee notes. Slight oak aftertaste
- 23 **Trefethen Vineyards Dragon's Tooth Red Oak Knoll Napa Vally 2015** \$ 95.00  
This alluring blend has rich aromas of ripe red plum, baking spices and cracked pepper. The palate is lush with flavors of cherries and dark berries. Malbec brings color and diversity of fruit; Petit Verdot and Cabernet Sauvignon lend the darker fruits and robust structure.
- 24 **Stags Leap The Investor, Napa, 2015** \$150.00  
Reflective of the winery's ability to combine power with elegance, the 2015 vintage of The Investor is rich in dark berry fruits alongside alluring notes of black licorice, pepper, tobacco leaf and leather, with touches of savory chaparral herbs, gingery orange zest, and hints of delicate floral on the nose.
- 26 **Staglin Family, Cabernet Rutherford 2012** \$ 255.00  
The polished and plushly textured palate, like liquid velvet generously endowed with juicy black cherries and ripe blackberries dripping with heady milk chocolate and a dusting of espresso, is deepened with just the slightest dash of tamari.
- 27 **Ghost Block, Oakville, 2014** \$150.00  
Intense overt aromas of bright raspberry and hints of cassis and mint jump out of the glass. The wine is a classic Napa Cabernet on the plate with enticing flavors of red fruits and dark mocha lengthened by the integrated floral notes of violets and rose petals.
- 28 **Pride Mountain Cabernet, Sonoma 2015** \$ 170.00  
The palate is rich, lush and opulent – virtually bursting with flavor – and its age-worthy tannins are present without being overwhelming.
- 29 **BV Tapestry Reserve Red Napa 2014** \$ 180.00  
Complex aromas of blackcurrants, tobacco and stones. Some oyster shell. Medium to full body, very fine tannins and a polished, refined, textured finish. A wine that harkens back to its traditions.

- 30 **Conch y Toro Don Melchor, Maipo Valley, 2013** \$ 210.00  
 A wine selected from the Tocornal vineyard in the Alto Maipo from vines planted in the mid '70's in alluvial soils on the north bank of the Maipo River. In warm years, the fruit for this wine often becomes round and voluptuous marked by sweet spice.
- 31 **Frank Family Cabernet, 2015** \$ 125.00  
 The 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon has an enticing nose of blackberries, bay leaf and graphite; on the palate the wine is full bodied, and reminiscent of cocoa-dusted dark chocolate truffles, cloves and blackberries
- 32 **Arns Cabernet Sauvignon St Helena Napa Valley, 2003** \$ 145.00  
 Nice dark color, some cedar and cassis. Nice mouthfeel, with lovely dark fruit up front, some cedar and vanilla on the midpalate, and a touch of nutmeg and spice on the back end. Nice tannins, medium finish. Well structured. Drinks smoothly.
- 33 **The Prisoner 2017 Napa Red Wine** \$ 148.00  
 Features enticing aromas of Bing cherry, dark chocolate, clove, and roasted fig. Persistent flavors of ripe raspberry, boysenberry, pomegranate, and vanilla linger harmoniously, for a smooth and luscious finish.
- 34 **Cakebread, Napa , 2015** \$ 170.00  
 Complex aromas of ripe blackberry and boysenberry with spice, dark chocolate and toasted oak notes. Beautifully balanced, richly textured flavors of black cherry, wild berry, cassis and mocha with a generously long finish. The wine is structured, delineated and vibrant.
- 35 **Caymus, Napa, 2016 one liter bottle** \$ 235.00  
 This wine has a signature style that is dark in color with rich fruit and ripe, velvety tannins. Caymus farms Cabernet grapes in with of Napa's sixteen sub-appellations with diversification enabling the winery to make the best possible wine in a given year. This Cabernet offers layered, lush aromas and flavors including cocoa, cassis and ripe dark berries
- 36 **Maxville, Napa, 2014** \$ 110.00  
 The 2014 Maxville Cabernet Sauvignon could easily be a poster child for this grape variety in the Napa Valley. The win exhibits black fruit richness, a firm and layered palate and a fine, full finish.
- 37 **Thorn Hill Three Sisters Cabernet Sauvignon 2013** \$ 85.00  
 The 2013 Three Sisters Cabernet tasting notes:  
 This cabernet possesses a gem-like garnet hue. Aromas of crushed berries and cassis are just the start. The harmonious flavors of blackberry, plum and cocoa finish with dusty tannins and spice notes. Aged in French oak barrels.

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| 38 | <p><b>Peltier Station, Lodi Cabernet Sauvignon, 2016</b></p> <p>This wine is tall, dark and handsome. Dressed in dark ruby, exuding dark fruit notes like blackberry, dark cherry, black currant and even pepper. A full body of more dark fruit, mocha and coffee ends with a long, dry but fruit forward finish</p>         | \$52.00  |
| 40 | <p><b>Ferrari-Carano Cabernet Sauvignon Alexander Valley</b></p> <p>Vibrant aromatics of cassis, mocha, dried cherries, mint, cola and smoky leather awaken the senses, while full-bodied flavors of black cherries and plums generously fill the palate. Lingering notes of toasty caramel round out the finish</p>          | \$ 90.00 |
| 41 | <p><b>Imagery, California, 2017</b></p> <p>This Cabernet Sauvignon is a soft, smooth wine with well-integrated oak. 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| 43 | <p><b>Scarbolo, Friuli, Italy, 2014</b></p> <p>The color is ruby red with violet hues. On the nose, fragrant aromas of wild berries and herbaceous notes of violets. Soft and silky body with sweet tannins and balanced structure.</p>                | \$ 80.00 |
| 44 | <p><b>Ferrari-Carano Sonoma 2016</b></p> <p>This is a velvety Merlot with a complex nose of cherry cola, cedar, vanilla and English toffee, followed by an enticing mouthfeel with flavors of plum, licorice, raspberry, mocha and cinnamon spice.</p> | \$ 85.00 |
| 49 | <p><b>Tangley Oaks, Napa, 2013</b></p> <p>Tangley Oaks Merlot is a well-balanced wine offering lush red berry and plum flavors along with notes of espresso. Silky tannins and a lingering finish.</p>   | \$ 38.00 |

## *Other Red Wines*

- 50     **Orin Swift Eight Years in the Desert Red Blend 2016**                     **\$210.00**  
Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2016 Zinfandel Blend Eight Years (a blend of Zinfandel, Petite Sirah and Syrah) comes bounding out of the glass with notes of raspberry pie, blackberry preserves and fruitcake. Full-bodied, rich and spicy in the mouth, it packs in the black fruit preserves, framed by chewy tannins and finishing on a savory note.
- 51     **Red Blend, Shafer TD9, Napa, 2016**                                     **\$ 190.00**  
Aged for twenty months in French oak and at a seemingly high ABV of 15.3%, this is a charming balancing act of Stags Leap-ian quality. Plush tannins are finely grained in this blend with notes of lavender, mocha cappuccino, black raspberry and saddle leather combine with an animal core-savory and dark. The finish is a hint of dark chocolate-covered orange peel.
- 52     **Justin Isosceles Red Blend Paso Robles CA Central Coast 2015**             **\$165.00**  
Dry and full bodied, layered with red and black cherry, cassis and complex baking spice on the entry. Sweet tobacco and classic savory pencil-like notes of cedar and graphite with a little cocoa emerge on the crisp mid-palate with firm chewy tannins lasting into a long, complex finish
- 53     **Brunello di Montalcino 2013**   **\$ 89.00**  
One of the most well-known and treasured wines in the world. It is a red wine of extraordinary elegance and concentration obtained from a long ageing process. It has a full and ethereal fragrance with hints of wild berries, black cherry and vanilla.
- 54     **Red Blend, Conundrum 2016**   **\$180.00**  
Sourced from premier California wine growing regions, Conundrum Red features dark red varietals including Zinfandel and Petite Sirah. It is rich, complex and approachable with lush flavors of cherries and baking chocolate.
- 55     **Shafer One Point Five, Napa, 2015**                                     **\$ 210.00**  
The vintage gave us ripe, beautiful fruit with abundant aromas and flavors. Round, rich, and smooth, 62% Merlot, 22% Malbec, 16% Cabernet Sauvignon and complex and compelling in the mouth serving up layer upon layer of red plum, briar and bramble fruit, black cherry, summer berry compote, and pomegranate with a touch of savory herbs.
- 56     **Tresor Ferrari-Carano Bordeaux Blend Sonoma 2013**                     **\$156.00**  
Vibrant aromas and flavors of boysenberry, cassis, anise, black cherry, and caramel come together with lingering plum on a long finish.
- 57     **Waltz Vineyards Baron Red Merlot/Cabernet, 2016, Lancaster PA**             **\$ 58.00**  
A great local winery producing a full bodied, fruit forward, dry red wine exhibiting notes of cherry, plum and herbs

- 59 **Meritage, Col Solare, Columbia Valley, Washington, 2014** \$ 121.00  
 This 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon is a celebration of the 20th vintage of Col Solare. The wine offers aromas of black cherry, currants, cinnamon and rose petals with subtle notes of vanilla, milk and chocolate.
- 60 **Il Fauno Di Arcanum, Toscana, 2015** \$ 86.00  
 The nose explodes with bright raspberries and wild berries, with some floral tones of lavender. Though a Bordeaux-style blend, the palate is more Burgundian with soft elegant tannins and textures. The slightly higher than usual acids firmly frame a potpourri of blueberry and sour cherry. The fruit slowly subsides giving way to exotic spice, reminiscent of cardamom and finishing with sweet black licorice.
- 62 **Syrah, Ramey, Rodgers Creek Vineyard, Sonoma Coast, 2009** \$ 118.00  
 Inky purple, smoky, complex aromas of candied black and blue fruits, violet, allspice and anise. Tight, sharply focused black currant and boysenberry flavors become sweeter and fleshier with air. A vibrant, graceful rendition of Syrah that finished with outstanding clarity and palate-straining
- 64 **Syrah, DuMol, Russian River Valley, 2008** \$ 125.00  
 Bright ruby purple color. Highly aromatic with violets, black pepper and soy opening to rich blackberry and dried herbs. Initially bright and fresh palate with graphite, cassis and spicy licorice then broadens to deep blackberries with a dark tapenade edge. Lovely inner mouth perfume and full rich mouth feel which easily absorbs the ripe tannins on the finish.
- 65 **Meritage Big Magic, Thorn Hill, California 2017** \$ 52.00  
 Their first attempt to create a blend like this with Cabernet Sauvignon, Zinfandel & Petite Sirah. Enticing Aromas of Cherry, Plum and mocha flavors that linger on a luscious finish.
- 66 **Corte Del Sole Amarone Della Valpolicella 2013** \$ 85.00  
 Wonderful and rich. The first aromas that hit you are violets and a stinging and sweet whiff of pipe tobacco. The palate takes in waves of dried cherries, prunes, bitter dark chocolate, a mineral touch of stone and the distinctiveness of vanilla.
- 67 **Veglio Michelino e Figlio Barolo, Italy 2012** \$ 60.00  
 Dried red fruit aromas make way for this full-bodied wine. Well-balanced with velvety tannins, outstanding ripeness and a long finish.
- 68 **Frogs Leap Zinfandel Napa Valley, 2017** \$ 88.00  
 Lush fruit, deep purplely color, mouth-filling flavors, perfect balance, remarkable drinkability. Great year for this wine that will also last for years to come.
- 70 **Zinfandel – Old Vine, Thorn Hill 1886 Lake County, 2014** \$ 68.00  
 History in a wine glass and planted in 1886. Its root stock is still producing an unparalleled vine Zinfandel with dark plum aromas, remarkable depth and jammy flavors. Dark berries, plum and chocolate culminate in a long peppery finish.

- 71 **Etude Pinot Noir, Carneros, 2017** \$62.00  
A vibrant red ruby color, this 2016 Carneros Pinot Noir shows lifted red berry fruit flavors and aromas of fresh strawberry, Bing cherry, and raspberry, along with the signature cinnamon graham cracker spice found in our Grace Benoist Ranch
- 73 **Ponzi Classico Pinot Noir Willamette Valley, 2015** \$ 92.00  
Aromas of ripe raspberry and black cherry are accentuated by crushed Mediterranean herbs of lavender, sage, rosemary and black tea. On the palate, dusty tannins are woven into hints of roasted coffee. Mouthwatering acidity is balanced by almond sweetness
- 74 **Pinot Noir, Imagery California, 2016** \$ 49.00  
This Pinot Noir is rich with jammy berry notes, silky tannins, and a long layered finish. Petit Verdot contributes to the beautiful color and substantial body of the wine.
- 77 **Pinot Noir, Benton Lane, Willamette Valley, 2014** \$ 74.00  
The fruit sweetness, a slight hint of black licorice and rose petals. The wine is amazing in its balance. You really have to taste it to get it.
- 78 **Pinot Noir Bitouzet-Prieur, Volnay, France, 2007** \$ 99.00  
Holding very well with med acidity gives just enough verve but retains a soft mouthfeel, med weight generous depth if not very complex warm earth and soft cherry remnants with a hint of greenness, finishes with good length, barely perceptible oak, and med tannins showing a slightly rustic astringency.
- 80 **Pinot Noir, Iris Vineyards, Willamette Valley, 2017** \$ 40.00  
Though more elegant and less rich than the winery's 2016, this value bottle is just as well-made and appealing. Sweet berry fruits, a mix of strawberry and raspberry, come with a bit of red cherry also. The tannins are gentle and smooth, the finish clean and long. The oak was 10% American, the rest French.
- 82 **Ferraton Pere & Fils Samorens Rouge Cotes Du Rhone, 2014** \$ 35.00  
Garnet core with ruby reflects. Nose: Aromas of very ripe red fruits Palate: Nicely structured. Aromas of blackberries, raspberries, blueberries and liquorice. Nice spices and herbs.
- 86 **Pinot Noir, Flowers, Sonoma Coast, 2016** \$ 135.00  
Medium ruby in color. Aromas of cranberry, deep raspberry and Santa Rosa plum are woven with top-notes of anise and coastal redwood spice. The palate is perfectly balanced with flavors of cherry and peach pith, broad tannins and textures of stone fruit flesh.

- 91 **Vina Real, Rioja Crianza 2016** \$ 47.00  
This wine shows shades of medium to deep shiny cherry color on a purple background. To the nose, intense aromas of ripe fruits (blackberries, blackcurrants) stand out, complemented with subtle hints of oak.
- 93 **Malbec, Red Schooner by Caymus, Voyage #7** \$ 78.00  
This Malbec is made from grapes grown in the Andes Mountains, shipped chilled to Napa Valley and produced with the same techniques as our Caymus Cabernet. Falling outside standard labeling rules, it does not include a vintage date but is known by the voyage from which it was produced. Offering scents of ripe plums and cherries, this wine is powerful and supple, with flavors of French oak and soft tannins.
- 94 **Malbec, Red Schooner by Caymus, Voyage #6** \$ 68.00  
This Malbec is made from grapes grown in the Andes Mountains, shipped chilled to Napa Valley and produced with the same techniques as our Caymus Cabernet. Falling outside standard labeling rules, it does not include a vintage date but is known by the voyage from which it was produced.

## WHITE WINES

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## *Chardonnay*

- 400 **Staglin Family Vineyard, Napa, 2010** \$ 100.00  
Offers an expressive nose of white flowers and tropical fruits intermixed with notes of kaffir lime and citrus rind. The clean, medium-bodied palate continues the citrus and tropical theme with a creamy interplay of key lime and banana cream pies tinged with notes of Madagascar vanilla and a wisp of toasty oak.
- 401 **Hartford Court, Stone Cote Vineyard, Sonoma Coast, 2010** \$ 146.00  
Bright, green-tinged yellow. Intensely perfumed bouquet evokes dried pear, honeydew, jasmine and chamomile. Spicy and firm on the palate, with bitter lemon and orchard fruit flavors lead to a long, supple, spice-dominated finish.
- 402 **Hyde de Villaine, Hyde Vineyard, Carneros, 2011** \$ 135.00  
A beautiful Carneros chardonnay with lemon peel, white flowers, mint and crushed rocks inform a tense, vibrant Chardonnay long on class and persistence. Here the aromas are bright, chiseled and beautifully focused throughout.
- 404 **Morgan Chardonnay, 2016** \$ 68.00  
Honey, graham cracker, and squash aromas are echoed on the palate, framed by fresh acidity and a hint of salinity - a nod to Double L's proximity to Monterey Bay. One of the finest food wines, the Double L Chardonnay will pair wonderfully with seafood and poultry dishes, as well as a buttery steak.
- 405 **Thorn Hill Chardonnay Napa 2016** \$ 55.00  
Napa Valley Chardonnay seduces with complex aromas of lemon-lime, pear, apple and melon. Deliciously fresh and delectable now, this youthful Chardonnay will blossom and gain further richness and complexity for years to come.
- 410 **Stag's Leap, Chardonnay, Napa, 2017** \$ 60.00  
The 2017 Chardonnay (aged eight months in 25% new oak) opens with fresh apples, Bosc pears and white grapefruit notes with wafts of honeysuckle and toasted almonds. Medium-bodied, the palate is vibrant, clean and wonderfully pure with loads of spiced apple nuances on the finish."
- 411 **Simonnet Febvre, Chablis 2013** \$ 40.00  
Textbook Chablis: 100% Chardonnay on Kimmeridgian marl and limestone soil aged in stainless steel. You can smell all the minerality, crispiness and freshness of this wine. Floral notes inebriate the palate too in a zesty, long-lingering finish

## *Other White Wines*

- 415 **White Blend, Prisoner Wine Company Blindfold, 2014** \$ 60.00  
The wine opens up with alluring aromas of freshly peeled mandarin orange, peach nectar, and honeydew melon. Hints of white citrus blossom, marzipan and toasted hazelnut add a nice layer of complexity. On the palette, the wine has a rich creamy entry that is balanced by bright acidity and minerality.
- 417 **Ponzi, Pinot Gris, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2016** \$ 45.00  
Aromas of guava, rose, white tea with an accent of wintergreen or spruce needle precede the textured palate laced with ginger spice, white pepper and peach. The finish is fresh and bright leaving a trail of lime zest and poached pear.
- 418 **Thorn Hill Pinot Grigio, 2016** \$ 38.00  
A wine that delights with aromas of pineapple, honeysuckle and peach and enraptures with lively flavors of citrus, pear and melon. The mid-palate has a vivid minerality and vibrant acidity with a refreshing lemon/lime finish.
- 422 **Fume Blanc, Robert Mondavi Napa, 2016** \$ 48.00  
Aromatic, white summer peaches with juicy Meyer lemon citrus, tangerine zest and a hint of gooseberry in each refreshing, mouthwatering sip.
- 424 **Colombard, Ugni blanc, Domaine Guillaman, Côtes de Gascogne France 2015** \$ 46.00  
The colour is pale yellow with beautiful glints of green, and brilliantly clear. The bouquet is exuberant and lets you dream: plenty of fruit (grapefruit, lychee, passion-fruit) and a hint of acacia.
- 425 **Cotes du Rhone Blanc, Perrin, Rhone, France, 2017** \$40.00  
Tasting like a top-flight Condrieu with its tangerine, honey, and floral aromas and flavors, it's pure, elegant, and impeccably balanced on the palate.
- 428 **Riesling, Kung Fu Girl Washington State, 2017** \$37.00  
White peach, mandarin orange and apricot are delivered with a core of minerality that makes this dry Riesling shimmer with energy and freshness.
- 429 **Reisling, Argyle Nuthouse Eola-Amity Hills, Oregon, 2014** \$ 38.00  
Light and tangy, with bright acidity to balance the refreshing pear and white pepper flavors. Floral notes show the finish.
- 431 **Riesling, St Urbans Hof, Mosel, 2016** \$ 36.00  
A pure, well-sculpted, off-dry version, with persimmon, lime and slate flavors coating the palate. Hints of orchard blossom and herbs add to the complexity, making you reach for another sip.

- 432 **Riesling, Gustave Lorentz Alsace France, 2016** \$ 46.00  
Pale yellow straw color. Fruity, floral, elegant aromas of orange blossom, vanilla lychee sorbet, and starfruit with a supple, racy, dry medium–full body and an appealing, medium-length fresh starfruit, bitter almond, and clementine zest finish with fruit, fine tannins and no oak flavor.
- 433 **Veltliner, Strasserhof, Alto-Adige, Italy, 2011** \$ 22.00  
Elegant nose of apple and tropical fruit. An ideal aperitif wine. Delicious with fresh fish and seafood.
- 434 **Willamette Valley Vineyards Rose Of Pinot Noir Willamette Valley 2018** \$ 44.00  
Electric pink in color with aromas of juicy strawberry, watermelon and ruby red grapefruit accented by floral honeysuckle. Dry with a medium-body, round mouthfeel and vibrant palate of nectarine, red cherry, tangerine and vanilla creme. The bright acidity creates a lively and clean finish.

## DESSERT WINES
